

**Privacy Policy 1. Introduction**

- 1) Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. This Privacy Policy constitutes an integral part of the agreement between you (also, the "User") and, as an owner of CPH4 by Ottentik services and other related products (also, the "Service," CPH4 by Ottentik").
- 2) This Privacy Policy describes the CPH4 by Ottentik privacy practices with regard to your Personal Data. Personal Data includes any data about you that specifically identifies you as an individual and information about your activities, such as information about your use of CPH4 by Ottentik, when directly linked to personally identifiable information.
- 3) You accept this Privacy Policy and consent to the collection, storage, use, and disclosure of your Personal Data in accordance with this Privacy Policy and applicable legislation.
- 5) References in this Privacy Policy to "we", "us", "our", "Controller", means CPH4 by Ottentik company, a swiss company.

**2. Collection and Usage**

- 1) We may collect some Personal Data automatically (your IP address, browser type and version, information about your visit including the URL clickstream to, through and from our Service, web pages you viewed or searched for, length of visits to certain web pages, web page interaction), through the use of tracking technologies including cookies in accordance with our Privacy Policy.
- 2) During the registration procedure and the use of our Service, we may collect some Personal Data. Hereunder you can see the possible collection of your Personal Data and how we use it:

Email password Account ID Phone number	We use these data to identify your activity in CPH4 by Ottentik, and these kinds of personal data are also used for providing you with your chosen services. We also use this information to provide you with necessary information and updates; for your identification and prevention of unauthorized access to your personal data
ETH, BTC, BNB Coin account number	We use this data to provide you opportunity to convert your ETH, BTC, BNB to CPH4
Social media accounts data - Twitter, Youtube, Instagram, TikTok, LinkedIn (optional)	We may use these data for cooperation purposes related to promoting CPH4 by Ottentik services

- 3) We also may use your Personal Data for the following purposes:
  - a) Processing of your inquiries and carrying out operations in relation to Service.
  - b) Analyzing and understanding our audience for the purposes of improving the Service.
  - c) Preventing, detecting and investigating potentially prohibited or illegal activities, including fraud.
  - d) Investigating violations of this Privacy Policy and/or the Terms and Conditions or enforce them, as well as to protect our rights and interests, and
  - e) Sending you marketing emails with information about our Services that we consider may be of interest to you. You may opt-out of such emails by sending the respective request to us or by clicking the respective link in the email.

Our dealings with you are based on:

- ✓ contractual dealings in the form of the public offer as per the Terms & Conditions on the website;
- ✓ your explicit consent for personal data processing in the form of a declaration (signed electronically) as a mandatory requirement of your CPH4 by Ottentik account registration or for your use of specific CPH4 by Ottentik features.

### **3. Disclosure**

We do not share certain information with other companies, organizations and individuals outside of the Company unless one of the following circumstances applies:

- 1) We will share your Personal Data with companies, organizations or individuals outside of the Company if we have a good-faith belief that access, use, preservation or disclosure of the Personal Data is reasonably necessary to:
  - a) meet any applicable law, regulation, legal process or enforceable governmental request.
  - b) enforce applicable legislation, including investigation of potential violations.
  - c) detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security or technical issues.
  - d) protect against harm to the rights, property or safety of the Company, our Users or the public as required or permitted by law.
  - e) facilitate the use of third-party services.
- 2) If the Company is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, we will continue to ensure the confidentiality of any Personal Data and give affected Users notice before Personal Data is transferred or becomes subject to a different privacy policy.
- 3) We won't share with other Users of the Service your name, email or other identifying information.

### **4. Third-parties services**

- 1) We may share Personal Data of our Users to third parties for the purposes of checking Users' payments, traffic measurement and/or advertising providers.
- 2) Our Service may contain links to and from third parties' websites, apps or other services (including social media). If you follow a link to any of them, please note that those websites have their own privacy practices. We shall not be liable for those respective policies and any collection, use or disclosure of your Personal Data in accordance thereto. Please check the third parties' privacy policies before you submit any Personal Data to their services.
- 3) If we use third-party vendors to perform certain services on behalf of us, such as hosting the site or application, analytical or other services, such third-party vendors may collect or have access to information about you (for example, automatically collected information through tracking technologies). Please recognize that we and/or our vendors may store this information and share this information with third parties as necessary to provide you with our services.

### **5. Data storage and security and cross-border transfer**

- 1) We will use all reasonable measures to protect your Personal Data from unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure or removal.  
The Service is equipped with the means of security and protection of your Personal Data.
- 2) Immediate access to your Personal Data is allowed only to us and persons authorized by us and involved in the maintenance of the Service. Such persons will strictly keep the confidentiality of and prevent unauthorized third-party access to your Personal Data.
- 3) Please remember that our Service may be hosted on a server outside your home country. By supplying us with your Personal Data, you permit its transfer outside the country, within the bounds of use of such Personal Data in accordance with the applicable law.
- 4) We emphasize that none of the existing ways of data transfer can be absolutely safe. The Company does not guarantee the absolute security of data in case of unauthorized access of third parties.
- 5) We shall not be responsible for unlawful acts of third parties, hackers, intruders, and other offenders of the applicable legislation that may violate the provisions of this Privacy Policy and try to collect, either fully or in part, your Personal Data and to use it for personal advantage.
- 6) As a general rule, the time limit for personal data processing and storage in CPH4 by Ottentik is 3 years from the date of your last activity or deletion of your account, which is ordinarily necessary to comply with applicable tax/revenue laws, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements.

BY GRANTING YOUR CONSENT TO THE USE OF CPH4 BY OTTENTIK, YOU EXPLICITLY AGREE THAT YOU HAVE BEEN DULY INFORMED AND HAVE AGREED THAT YOUR PERSONAL DATA WILL BE STORED AND PROCESSED AT THE REGISTERED ADDRESS OF CPH4 BY OTTENTIK IN SWITZERLAND, OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION OR EEA MEMBERSTATES, IN A MANNER AS IS DESCRIBED BY THIS PRIVACY POLICY.

### **6. Children's privacy**

We do not collect, use or share the Personal Data of children (under the age of majority per the applicable law). You must be a legal adult to access our Service under the applicable law and the law of the country where you are located.

## **7. Cookies**

1) To ensure that our Service functions properly, we may use various tracking technologies like cookies, web beacons or similar technologies. By using the Service, you provide us your consent for our use of cookies and similar tracking technologies under the terms hereof.

2) Cookies are small data files that are commonly stored on your device when you browse and use websites and online services. They are widely used to make websites work or to work more efficiently, as well as to provide reporting information and assist with service or advertising personalization.

3) We, or third parties with our permission, may use cookies in the following ways:

- a) To manage our business and improve our Service based on factors such as how many Users visit or use our Service, what pages and views are accessed, whether visitors are new or repeat visitors, which features of our Service most interest our visitors etc.
- b) To provide personalized recommendations, advertising, marketing emails, and guidance on Service features based on your activity on our Service and browsing activities.
- c) To remember actions you took to avoid asking you to repeat them during a session or to provide features such as enabling you to resume reading at the last page you accessed, synchronized across devices.
- d) To measure and analyze activity on our services, or third-party services. In addition, we or any provider of such measurement and analytical services may provide non-personally identifiable data to third parties.
- e) The User may block, clear and delete cookies in accordance with the instruction for their web-browser and/or device settings.

## **8. Use of automated decision-making and profiling**

You hereby shall be duly informed of the existence of automated decision-making algorithms (including profiling) used by us that assist us to improve our experience of communication with you as our User. For example, such automated decision-making algorithms may profile you based on your browsing history and advertises that you click on our website to help us customize the advertisement showing to you according to your interests.
